Use the information that you have gathered this quarter, from social studies, to complete the following assignment.

George Washington, John Adams, Thomas Jefferson and James Madison were the first four presidents of the United States. Working together, and with each other's ideas in mind, they began the country that we know today.

Use the knowledge you have from class to build a jigsaw puzzle of the United States- with at least 15 pieces. On each puzzle, there should be important information about the first eight presidents and the first twelve states that we have talked about.

This project should be done with construction paper, which I will provide, and markers. Please use pencil first, then trace with markers.

Once you are finished, cut the pieces apart, and place them in a ziplock bag, with your name on it, and turn it in!
