Use the following guideline if it makes it easier for you!</p> <p><u>Paragraph 1:</u> Write the name of the book, author, number of pages and the genre (type) of book you read. (1-2 sentences)</p> <p><u>Paragraph 2:</u> Describe the main character(s) using at least 2 different adjectives and tell why you chose those adjectives. (3-4 sentences)</p> <p><u>Paragraph 3:</u> Write a summary of the book. (10-20 sentences)</p> <p><u>Paragraph 4:</u> Tell why you liked or didn't like this book. Who would you recommend it to? (2-4 sentences)</p> <p>You don't need to make a cover, but it's ok if you do!</p>
