

Interjection

An interjection is a word or group of words used to express feelings. Interjections can be mild or strong. For example, in "Oh, now I see him," the interjection is "Oh," and it is mild because it is followed by a comma. Or, in "Wow! We won the election," "Wow" is the interjection, and it is strong because it is followed by an exclamation point.

It may be helpful to use the list of common interjections below to develop a series of sentences and have the student identify the interjections. Or, provide the student with an interjection, and have him or her verbalize a sentence using the preposition.

Wow
Oh
Ow
Yikes
Hey

Also, have the student identify the interjection in sentences:

Sentence: Hey! I really need your attention.

Interjection: Hey
