

Fraction Spelling

Make a table with four columns. Write this week's spelling words in the first column. In the second column, write in fraction form the number of vowels in each word. Then write the number of consonants, in fraction form, in the third column. (Hint: you will need to know the total number of letters in each word before you can write the fractions)

Example:

WORD	VOWELS	CONSONANTS
finger	2/6	4/6
small	1/5	4/5

In the example above, the word *finger* has six letters. Two of those letters, or $2/6$ of the letters, are vowels, and four of the letters, or $4/6$, are consonants.
