



It's time to start reading again!

It's Reading Time!!!!!! It's time to start working on your reading goal for our third reading celebration--It will be A Party to Remember!

To continue promoting reading, Anniston 1<sup>st</sup> Graders will continue to participate in a year round reading program. The ultimate goal is that every child and 1<sup>st</sup> grade teacher will read a total of 2600 minutes each this school year! If we reach our goal, the 1<sup>st</sup> grade at Anniston Avenue Elementary will have read a total of 4550 hours!

The Reading Celebration Requirements are as follows:



The reader keeps a log of reading times. This log will need to be signed by the parent and/or teacher. This log will be checked weekly by your child's teacher. If a child loses the log, he or she will have to start from the beginning. Reading logs may not be "backdated".



Your child may continue to read books, magazine, or newspaper articles. The subject should be any age-appropriate material.



Time spent reading to or with others counts toward the goal!!



It is your child's responsibility to turn in their Reading Log when requested by the teacher.

Let's continue Reading!! In order to attend the school-wide reading celebration on March 11<sup>th</sup>, the student will need to read a total of 700 minutes between January 4<sup>th</sup> and February 24<sup>th</sup>! We will submit names on February 25<sup>th</sup>!

(700 minutes= approximately 22 minutes of reading a night (Monday-Thursday) for each week.)
