



### **REQUIREMENTS FOR CLASS:**

1. Students must keep up with all assignments by reading their calendar syllabus.
2. Must complete a study guide and quiz over each chapter.
3. Each test usually includes from two to three chapters of material and will be presented in the form of multiple-choice, short answer, or essay.
4. Each semester you will have outside reading (novels, documents) pertaining to the time period we are studying and tests over this material will be given. Every month students are responsible for completing **TWO** outside reading worksheets.
5. Students are required to take the mid-term, final, End-Of-Course test (counts 15% of your final grade), as well as the **AP Exam at the end of the year (price of test-about \$85.00-due this month).**
